ISLAY

Islay is the southernmost region of the Scottish island chain, also the home of the most distinctive Scottish single malts whiskies. This particular character stems from the peat. Over the centuries, the peat has become infused with salty seawater, which contains iodine and remains of seaweed. This gives the whiskies a medicinal character and a salty smell and taste! Powerful, dry and smoky are the hallmarks for whiskies from Islay. This island is home to no fewer than eight distilleries.

SPEYSIDE

Speyside is a relatively small region where the leading single malts in all of Scholtand come from. Speyside single malts are sweeter in flavour with influences from sultanas to ripe fruit. This sweetness comes from the sherry-aged wooden casks. Whiskies often contain hints of nuts and malt. Depending on the barley drying on peat, so does smokiness. Due to the lack of peat, most whiskies are characterised solely by a hint of peat. Speyside malts can be lighter and strongly floral, or robust, rich malt with a hint of sherry.

HIGHLANDS

Highlands has it all! A smooth or yet a robust whisky with a sophisticated sea breeze? The Highlands is simply too vast to put its whiskies into one category. If you still want to think in one big line, you can describe the whiskies as a robust single malt with deeper notes of peat and smoke. Geography influences style and flavour of Highland whiksy. A typical whisky from the north can be recognised by its malty-sweet flavours and strong floral, heathery scents. Whiskies from the south, also called Midland, tend to be softer and lighter with distinct dryness and fruity influences. In the east, stretching along the North Sea coast, whiskies are full-bodied and dry with plenty of fruit and a present sharpness. The west produces full-bodied, pronounced single malts, with a refined, light peat and smokeiness. The area also has the typical Maritime Highland whisky, a whisky distilled close to the coast. The closer you get, the more sea you taste. This ranges from seaweed, brine and shellfish, to beach fires, sea breeze and iodine-rich algae.
